

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

January 18, 1924.

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District Room 740 Thatcher Bldg., at 10 A. M. January 18, 1924. The meeting was called to order and presided over by Chairman Chas. W. Lee. Directors present: Lee, Raber, Nuckolls. Directors absent: none.

Mr. Raber introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, heretofore, pursuant to public notice and call for bids, proposals in writing have been received by The Pueblo Conservancy District for the doing of certain work and furnishing certain materials, and the said proposals have been examined by the Directors of said District, and they are now fully advised in the premises, NOW, THEREFORE:
