MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

January 27, 1953

A Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held at the office of the District, 113 West Fifth Street, at 10:00 A. M. o'clock on January 27, 1953.

Directors Present: John M. Holmes and W. T. Mathis.

The minutes of the meeting of November 19, 1952, were read and approved.

Upon motion of Mr. Holmes, seconded by Mr. Mathis, the sale of Certificates listed below was approved because they were sold in a manner believed to be in the best interest of the District and the property holder:

Greene submitted records of Certificates cancelled by Court Decree where property has been acquired by Tax Title based on delinquent general taxes. Cancellation records submitted are numbered 72 to 74 inclusive, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof. Greene reported that to the best of his knowledge these cancellations were in order. Upon motion of Mr. Mathis, seconded by Mr. Holmes, the cancellation of taxes as shown on pink sheets Nos. 72 to 74 inclusive, were ratified and approved.

Mr. Holmes stated that this meeting had been called for the purpose of formally authorizing the filing of an application for a Tax Title on the Pueblo Labor Temple Association property. He stated that on January 24, 1953, he had talked to both Mr. Mathis and Mr. Pryor and each approved of such action. Mr. Holmes then read a memo re the Labor Temple Association after which he moved that the memo be made a part of the minutes of this meeting. The motion was seconded and carried. The memo is as follows.

Memo re Pueblo Labor Temple Association:

The annual Conservancy District assessment on the Labor Temple is \$568.86. No assessment has been paid since 1931. The total face value of the Tax Sale Certificates representing the unpaid assessments is \$13,224.32. This includes the 1952 assessment.

Soon after Greene was appointed Secretary-Treasurer in 1945, he wrote to the Secretary of the Labor Temple Association re these unpaid assessments. He received no reply. He called on various occasions at the Secretary's office. The Secretary was always out and ignored requests to contact Greene.

Although Greene's repeated efforts to get the Labor Association to confer with him met with failure, it was the concensus of opinion of the Conservancy District Directors as well as the opinion of Greene and Attorney Rose that in view of the fact that the District's claim which constituted a lien against the property of the Labor Association appeared to be well secured that the interest of the District was not being jeopardized by delay in taking drastic action. All of the time however Greene was making periodic checks to make sure that the general taxes were being paid. Then in 1951 the Labor Association did not pay the 1950 general taxes and a Tax Sale Certificate was issued December 3, 1951, which was promptly acquired by the Conservancy District.

Soon after the District acquired this Certificate, Greene sent registered letters (return receipts requested and received) to Secretary Graves and President Pearson of the Labor Association. No reply was received. However, A. B. Chasteen, who was not an officer of the Association did call on Greene - said he knew the Conservancy taxes should be paid and said he would try to get the Association to do something about them. He apparently met with no success.

At about the same time Greene was trying to get a reply from Graves and Pearson, Rose was contacting A. T. Stewart, Attorney for the Labor Association. Stewart, like Chasteen, said the taxes should be paid. He called on Holmes and Greene and said

he would try to get some action. The original corporate charter of the Association had expired in 1936, and the surviving members of the last Board of Directors were acting as Trustees. Stewart said he would, and he did, reincorporate the Association.




Stewart, Chasteen and O. E. McGuire met with Holmes and Greene October 27, 1952, and Stewart said he believed he could get all of the surviving Directors of the old corporation to sign a deed on the property conveying it to the new corporation, and then the new corporation would be in a position to negotiate a loan or take some course of action. He asked that the Conservancy District delay taking action for 30 days and that at the expiration of the 30 days he would report progress. He did not report to Holmes and Greene but he and Rose conferred frequently and finally on January 24, 1953, Stewart told Rose he had been unable to get the Directors of the old corporation to cooperate in signing the deed. Rose told him the District, under the circumstances, was going to apply for a Tax Deed and Stewart offered no objection nor did he ask that the action be further delayed.

After reading the foregoing memo, Mr. Holmes moved and Mr. Mathis seconded the motion, which was carried, that Greene file without delay the application for a Tax Deed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
