Gentlemen:

You are hereby authorized to proceed with the construction of the sand gate in the Bessemer Ditch about 2000 feet below the Rock Canyon Barrier, according to the attached drawings.

From your letter of October 1, and verbal conversations, we understand the prices to be as follows:

Excavation, from the upper to the lower end of the concrete structure to be measured to the vertical planes bounding the base of the structure. Downstream from the lower end of the concrete structure to be the actual excavation as measured. Price, \$0.75 per cubic yard. This price for excavation also includes backfill along the sides and behind the walls of the concrete structure up to the elevation of the top of the barrel.

Backfill above the elevation of the top of the barrel, price \$0.25 per cubic yard, measured between the vertical planes bounding the base of the structure and lines and grades given by the engineer.

Concrete, price \$19.00 per cubic yard. Lumber for forms and reinforcing steel to be furnished f.o.b. Pueblo by the District.

Placing and bending reinforcing steel and placing steel guides for gate, \$0.03 per bb.

Building and installation of wooden gate, stand etc., \$20.00 lump sum.

Lumber for gate, gate rod, stand and anchor bolts to be furnished f.o.b. Pueblo by the District.
