Mr. Holmes moved and Mr. Pryor seconded the motion which was unanimously carried that the amount paid the Secretary-Treasurer each month as compensation, rent, etc., be increased retroactive to October 1, 1947, to \$275.00 a month. Mr. Holmes stated that on or about October 15th, he had consulted both Mr. Mathis and Mr. Pryor at their places of business regarding this increase, at which time it was agreed that at the next Director's meeting a motion authorizing the increase would be passed and made a matter of record.

The rest of the meeting was devoted to a discussion of the condition of the river channel East of Santa Fe Avenue and the condition of all the levees West of Santa Fe Avenue. S. F. Elliot who had been invited to be present joined in this discussion. Mr. Elliot reported that a diversion dam constructed for the purpose of diverting irrigation water into the "Booth Ditch" appeared to him to be decreasing the carrying capacity of the river of the river East of Santa Fe Avenue and he recommended a further study of this situation be made. He suggested, and his suggestion was accepted, that he write to the U.S. Army Engineers at Albuquerque and inquire as to what data they had acquired when they did some investigation of the carrying capacity of this portion of the channel earlier in the year.

Mr. Greene was instructed to write to the U.S. Army Engineers at Albuquerque on another matter namely: to inquire if they would inspect the levees and make any repairs needed.

Mr. Greene was also instructed to authroize the Blackburn Engineering Company to have two of their men cut the volunteers trees and weeds which have grown in the river channel.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
