

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

November 27, 1923.

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District was held in Room 740 Thatcher Building, at 10:30 A.M. November 27, 1923.

The meeting was presided over by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District.

Directors present: Lee, Reber, Nuckolls.

Directors absent: none.

Minutes of the meeting of November 16, 1923 were read, and, upon motion, approved.
