The Secretary presented to the meeting a receipt in duplicate from A. H. Stanard, Treasurer of the County of Pueblo, showing the deposit with said officer, on December 8, 1925, of the Construction Fund Assessment Record, with extension of assessments as provided in the resolutions of April 14, 1925 and September 8, 1925. Said receipt was ordered filed in the records of the District.

The Secretary then presented to the Board the written offer of the International Trust Company for the bonds, par value of \$92,000, remaining in the consolidated issue authorized by resolutions of April 14 1925 and Septem er 8, 1925, after deduction of the amount paid in cash by owners of property to the Treasurer of the District. The said offer was as follows:

"Pueblo, Colorado, Dec. 15, 1925.

To the Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District, Pueblo, Colorado.

Gentlemen:

We hereby offer to pay to The Pueblo Conservancy District upon delivery to us of legally issued Conservancy Bonds of The Pueblo Conservancy District, in denominations of \$1,000, and in the total amount of not to exceed \$92,000, as hereinafter set forth, dated April, 1, 1925, due

2,000 in each of the years commencing December 1, 1926 to December 1, 1932, inclusive 3,000 in the year commencing December 1, 1933 2,000 in each of the years commencing December 1, 1934 to December 1, 1937, inclusive 3,000 in each of the years commencing December 1, 1938 to December 1, 1947, inclusive 4,000 in each of the years commencing December 1, 1948 to December 1, 1950, inclusive 5,000 in each of the years commencing December 1, 1951 to December 1, 1955, inclusive

with all number of unmatured coupons attached; both principal and semi-annual interest payable, at the holder's option, at the office of the Treasurer of The Pueblo Conservancy District in Pueblo, Colorado, or at the banking house of Bankers Trust Company, at New York, N. Y., as follows: Par and all accrued interest. This is for bonds bearing $4\frac{8}{4}\%$ interest.

This bid is based upon delivery of bonds as soon after the acceptance of this bid as said bonds can be printed and legal requirements complied with; said bonds are to be delivered to us and payment therefor made at Denver, Colorado, accompanied by the final approving opinion of Messrs. Pershing, Nye, Takinadge & Bosworth of Denver;

Y.; said bonds to be delivered and paid for at Denver, Colorado, accompanied by the final approving opinion of Messrs. Pershing, Nye, Tallmadge & Bosworth; the District to pay for such approving opinion
