March 14, 1951

A Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District was held at the office of the District, 113 West Fifth Street at 2:00 P. M., o'clock on March 14, 1951.

Mr. Holmes brought up for discussion the matter of the appropriation, by the Congress in Washington, of funds for building the backwater levee, and read the following excerpt from a memo he had written to Colonel Keck.

"The Flood Control Act approved 17 May 1950 authorized a project for flood protection along the Arkansas River at Pueblo, Colorado, substantially in accordance with the recommendations of the Chief of Engineers as contained in House Document 327-81st Congress. The plan of improvement provides for additional local flood protection, for the area subject to inundation by backwater at Pueblo, by the construction of a levee along the left bank of the river extending from the north abutment of the Santa Fe Avenue Bridge to high ground adjacent to the Missouri Pacific Railroad right-of-way. The estimated Federal cost of the project is \$217,500. This would protect against flooding by backwater to the same extent as 110,000 c.f.s. as the carrying capacity of the main channel of the Arkansas River through the City of Pueblo."

In January 1951, Greene had written to M. C. Chenoweth asking the status of this appropriation. Chenoweth advised that there seemed to be a disposition on the part of Congress not to appropriate funds for any project which had no bearing on the Defense Program. Chenoweth later reported that he had various contacts with the Engineer in Charge of the Civil Functions of the Army Engineers in Washington, and that this Engineer seemed friendly to our project. Greene phoned Colonel McNutt of the Albuquerque District of the Corps of Engineers and Colonel McNutt advised that the Albuquerque Office still recommended the Pueblo project. At the request of the Pueblo Conservancy District, Mr. R. C. Woodson of the Albuquerque Office came to Pueblo and met at the Conservancy office on February 16, 1951, with Congressman Chenoweth, Attorney Rose, S. F. Elliot, Engineer for the Conservancy District, and Holmes and Greene. Mr. Woodson stated that this project had been approved and would remain on the Federal records as the law until the project was completed or the Conservancy District itself advised that the project was not necessary.

Woodson stated that the Albuquerque Office had gone as far as it could in the matter and that the best chances for the District to get the appropriation this year would be through efforts on the part of local citizens to convince the authorities in Washington that a flood in Pueblo would be detrimental to the Defense Program.

Following a telephone call from Chenoweth in Washington to Greene on March 2, 1951, Holmes, Rose and Greene had a conference on March 3rd and at this conference, Holmes stated that he would undertake to contact Colonel Keck of the Pueblo Ordnance Depot, Jay J. Martin of the CF&I Corporation and various railroad officials and industrialists in Pueblo, requesting that each write a letter to the effect that the failure of the present backwater levee to hold would be decidedly detrimental to the Defense effort. At the meeting held today, Holmes reported that he had seen Colonel Keck, Jay J. Martin and others and that they would either write Chenoweth and send the letters to Washington or would send letters to the office of the District in Pueblo to forward to Washington.



Mr. Mathis made a motion which was seconded by Mr. Holmes and carried to the effect that in conformity with the 1950 Amendments to the Federal Social Security Law, employees of the Pueblo Conservancy District be covered for social security benefits. The Secretary was instructed to file with the Social Security Department any forms which might be necessary.

After the business of the meeting as recorded above had been concluded, Mr. Mathis and Mr. Holmes continued the meeting without the Secretary-Treasurer being present. This continuation of the meeting was for the purpose of discussing the salary of the Secretary-Treasurer, the result being that on motion by Mr. Holmes, seconded by Mr. Mathis and carried, the salary of the Secretary-Treasurer be increased to \$325.00 per month retroactive to March 1, 1951.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
