MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

March 26, 1946

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District was held at the office of the District, 113 West Fifth Street, at 7:30 P.M. o'clock on March 26, 1946

Directors present: John M. Holmes, W. T. Mathis, Frank Pryor

Also present: S. F. Elliot, Engineer for the District.

The minutes of the meeting of January 15, 1946, were read and approved.

The Secretary reported he had seen Mr. T. S. Underwood and Mr. Underwood said it would be agreeable to him to make his annual audit as of December 31st instead of May 31st, if Judge Leddy so ordered. Mr. Underwood called attention to the fact he was appointed as Auditor by Judge Leddy and his report is made to Judge Leddy. The Secretary then discussed the matter with Judge Leddy, who took the position that unless the changing of the date was a matter of considerable importance, he believed it advisable to let the May 31st date for the audit remain in effect. Upon receiving this report from the Secretary, Mr. Holmes called attention to the fact that heretofore the Directors had relied on Mr. Underwood's reports for certain information regarding the financial condition of the District but that changes in the bookkeeping system now made all information available at any time and that it was therefore a matter of no importance to the Directors when Mr. Underwood made his report. It was agreed by all the Directors present to let the May 31st date for the report remain in effect without discussing the matter further with either Mr. Underwood or Judge Leddy.

The minutes of the meeting of March 19, 1946, were read and approved.

Mr. Mathis introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District: That the petition heretofore presented to the Board by the Burch Warehouse and Transfer Company and The Jackson Carlile Land Company for distribution of benefits of Lots 10 to 18, Block 2, Moore's Subdivision, be and the same is hereby granted and the President of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to file a waiver and consent in court, proceeding accordingly, and all acts of the officers of the Pueblo Conservancy District in conformity with this resolution are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Pryor and upon being put to vote was unanimously passed.

Mr. Mathis introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District: That the petition heretofore presented to the Board by Guy G. Stringer, Byron M. Drake, Abe Litvack, Rose Litvack, Emanuel Stein and Ruth Stein for distribution of benefits of the SW 21' of Lot 29 and all of Lots 30, 31 and 32, Block 50, South Pueblo, be and the same is hereby granted and the President of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to file a waiver and consent in court, proceeding accordingly, and all acts of the officers of the Pueblo Conservancy District in conformity with this resolution are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Pryor and upon being put to vote was unanimously passed.

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Mr. Elliot reported that he had carefully examined the plans and specifications prepared by the U. S. Engineers for the repair of the levee, and had made such revisions as appeared advisable. These revisions were discussed and it was the concensus of opinion that the plans and specifications as revised were satisfactory and that all necessary steps should be taken to hasten the completion of the repairs.

Mr. Mathis introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED, That whereas a portion of the levee is washed out near Santa Fe Avenue, the plans and specifications prepared by the U. S. Engineers and revised by S. F. Elliot be and are hereby approved; that copies of these plans and specifications be prepared for contractors desiring to bid on the job, that the advertisement for bids be inserted in the Pueblo Star Journal and Chieftain on March 31st, 1946, and every day thereafter until April 12th, that bids be opened at the office of the Secretary by the Directors of the District at 2:00 o'clock P.M. on April 12th, 1946.

Mr. Pryor seconded the motion to adopt the resolution and the vote in favor was unanimous.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
