Holmes reported that the work in repairing the jetty east of and near to the Santa Fe Avenue bridge was nearly completed. The work called for digging a trench under the wire netting which confines slag in the jetty and filling the trench with concrete to prevent slag from washing from under the netting.

Holmes reported that he believed it advisable to have some heavy duty earth moving equipment cut down several high places in the channel near to and east of the Santa Fe Avenue bridge - putting some of the dirt moved on the south bank of the channel and some against the newly repaired jetty. Pryor and Mathis authorized Holmes to proceed.
