## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

## April 7, 1925]

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. April 7, 1925. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, chairman of the Board. Directors present: Lee and Nuckolls. Directors absent: Breckenridge. Owing to the absence of Mr. Breckenridge, the Secretary acted as Chairman of the meeting. The minutes of the meetings of March 17 and 24 were read, and approved.

Mr. Nuckolls introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District: That the Tressurer of The Pueblo Conservancy District is hereby authorized to sell at market price U. S. securities in amount of \$250,000. par value, now held by said officer as part of proceeds of bonds of said District.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, the vote resulting as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

The following resolution was then introduced by Mr. Nuckolls, who moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District, that in the matter of completing the work at the Barrier, Platt Rogers, Inc. is to put in a cofferdam on force account and the District is to assume \$10.00 per day as loss incurred by Rogers on commissary, also Craig's salary. But if the work on north side of river is pushed to completion simultaneously with work on south side, Craig's salary is to be divided equally between Rogers and the District and no commissary account to District.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, the vote being as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

Mr. Nuckolls then introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District, That the payment of the sum of \$1553.50 to the Pueblo Terminal Railway Company and the conveyance of certain lands made to said Pueblo Terminal Railway Company by the Pueblo Conservancy District, be, and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved, the said payment and conveyance being in full settlement of controversy of the amount to be paid for the taking of certain lands described in the Conservancy Appraisal Record as File No. 1770b. File No. 1772, File No. 1768, File No. 1773b, File No. 1774b and File No. 1800; the said Pueblo Terminal Railway Company being successors in interest of the owners of the lands so taken, the said conveyance being made to said Terminal Company at the request of said owners.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Lee, the vote resulting as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

The following resolution was introduced by Mr. Nuckolls, who moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the conveyance of certain lands to the Colorado-Kansas Railway heretofore made by the Pueblo Conservancy District be, and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved, the said conveyance being made pursuant to the obligation of the District to provide equal facilities in lieu of right-of-way taken, except such land included in said conveyance as was included in the settlement with the owners of lands described in the Conservancy Appraisal Record as File No. 1770b, File No. 1772, File No. 1768, File No. 1773b, File No. 1774b and File No. 1800, and which was included in said conveyance to the Colorado-Kansas Railway at the request of

said owners and their successors in interest.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, the vote resulting as follows:

Nuckolls; Nays: none. Ayes: Lee. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

Mr. Nuckolls then introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

> BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that one share of stock of the West Pueblo Ditch & Reservoir Company be assigned to Ben Wolff pursuant to settlement agreement for lands taken.

Mr. Lee seconded themotion, which resulted in the following vote:

Ayes: Nuckoll s; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.
