MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

May 26, 1925

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. May 26, 1925. Directors present: Lee and Nuckolls. Directors absent: Breckenridge. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, but the Secretary acted as Chairman of the meeting owing to the absence of Mr. Breckenridge. The minutes of the meeting of May 19, were read, and mpon motion, approved.
