A meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District was held at the office of the District, 113 East Fifth Street, Pueblo, Colorado, at 10:00 A.M., 4 May 1962.

The Court Order appointing Mr. James M. Martin to the Board of Directors to fill the unexpired term of the late Walter Mathis, which term will expire February 24, 1963, with his Oath of Office is hereby accepted and is attached to and made a part of these minutes.

The re-appointment of L. M. Rhoades, whose present term will expire on June 5, 1962, is hereby accepted, which re-appoints him for a term of five years beginning June 5, 1962, is hereby ordered attached to and made a part of these minutes.

A letter dated April 19 was received from the Pueblo Gas & Fuel Company, and was read, requesting slight changes in the plans of putting a pipe line on the Conservancy property south of the Arkansas River.

It was moved by Rhoades and seconded by Martin that the plan be approved and that the Gas Company be so notified. Motion carried.

A letter dated May 2 from the Kaufman Agency was read with reference to the desired purchase of approximately 24.28 feet of lot 26, block 38 in the former town of South Pueblo, same being in the 300 block on Victoria Avenue.

It was moved by Martin, seconded by Rhoades that Kaufman Agency be advised that we will sell the property but only on a cash basis, price of which to be agreed upon. Motion carried.

It was moved by Rhoades, seconded by Martin that Engineer Elliot be instructed to proceed with the Engineering and Plans and Specifications for the repair of the dirt back of the north bank of the Arkansas River West of Union Avenue and across from the Union Depot.

The report of Engineer Elliot, dated April 23, with reference to certain repairs on the Levee was received and ordered attached to and made a part of these minutes.

It was moved by Rhoades, seconded by Martin that Holmes take steps to have the work done. Motion carried.

It was moved by Rhoades, seconded by Martin that Holmes be instructed to contact City Manager Fellows with reference to duming dirt fill over the top of the Union Avenue Bridge railing, motion carried.

It was moved by Rhoades and seconded by Martin that Holmes be instructed to go to Denver to contact the Denver & Rio Grande WesternR. R. Company with reference to the removal of their pipe line from the north bank of the Arkansas River opposite the Union Avenue Depot where work will be done. He is also to take up with the Railroad the feasibility of using Railroad facilities for handling the necessary earth to do the work, same to be reported on at a later meeting. Motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 11:30 A.M.

To the Board of Directors Pueblo Conservancy District 113 East Fifth Street Pueblo, Colorado

Gentlemen:

I have completed the annual inspection of the Conservancy works, with the exception of Rock Creek Dam, and found the structures in excellent condition, and in need of only minor repairs and maintainence. The results of my inspection are as follows:

- 1. The toe of concrete slabs at stations 14, 14/200, and 14/300 need repair with mastic filler; as the Directors will recall, this was repaired immediately by Gottula in order to take advantage of the low stage of the river at the time of inspection.
- 2. All bridges across the channel, with the exception of W. 4th Street are badly in need of paint. This, as has been reported in previous years, is merely a matter of record, as the responsibility for the bridges rests with the City of Pueblo.
- 3. Concrete slabs 75' and 150' east of Main Street should be patched with mastic.
- 4. Saplings should be removed from the levee, from Station 22, east to Santa Fe Avenue.
- 5. Slabs should be backfilled and compacted, S.W. corner, levee, Santa Fe Avenue bridge.
- 6. Gopher holes should be filled, S. levee, between Freeway & D.& R.G.W. bridge.
- 7. Slab should be grouted, S. levee, 100' E. of D. & R. G. W. bridge.
- 8. Slabs should be filled with soil, top of levee, 24/475.
- 9. Drainage ditches adjacent to and E. of Runyan Field should be cleared of weeds.
- 10. Stone rip-rap, south bank, above and below Union Avenue should be cleaned of growth, and holes in stone work filled with concrete.

- ll. The strip between the sidewalk and rip-rap, S. side of Union Avenue, between Union Avenue bridge and buildings, should be filled with grout; sapling adjacent thereto should be cut out.
- 12. Piers supporting south end of Union Avenue bridge appear to have deteriorated badly since our last inspection. This is a matter of record only, since the responsibility for the bridge lies with the City, and was recently inspected and reported on by the Director of Public Works.
