May 5, 1925

The following resolution was introduced by Mr. Nuckolls who moved its adoption:

Mr. Nuckolls then introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the contract between The Pueblo Conservancy District and the Salle Construction Company for the laying of track for the Colorado-Kansas Railway grade between its crossing of the Santa Fe Railway new Dry Creek and the Santa Fe Railway bridge near First St., as the same has be n heretofore executed, be, and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Lee, the vote resulting as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declaree the motion passed.
