Holmes explained that he and Elliot and Axel Salmonson of the State Highway Department, and Clarence Brown and Roy Alber of the Pioneer Construction Company, had gone to look over the old river channel east of the Southern Colorado Power Company siphon to the Missouri Pacific siphon.

Holmes, who had been previously authorized to correct certain levels of the land on the east side of Sants Fe Avenue took up with Brown and Salmonson regarding the condition in which the Pioneer Construction Company had left the levels of the land between the fill and the syphon. Brown agreed to correct the level of the land according to his and Elliot's idea.

Then all of the above mentioned parties inspected the condition of the old river channel between the new highway fill and the culvert underneath the Missouri Pacific tracks. It was mutually agreed by all concerned that for the sake of health, appearance and storage of run off water, that the channel, could be cleaned up and reshaped. Brown stated that he felt the job could be properly done on a force account basis - the cost of which would run between \$2500.00 and \$3000.00. It was moved by Rhoades and seconded by Mathis that Holmes secure a rental schedule of equipment from Brown and proceed with the work at a figure not to exceed that above mentioned.

The proposition of the Certified Concrete Company desiring a lease on the Conservancy ground for the erection of a crusher plant was discussed. No conclusion was reached. Holmes and Elliot were instructed to contact the Certified Concrete Comapny and make a further report to the Directors at a later meeting.

Copies of Underwood's audit for the fiscal year ending May 31, 1958, were submitted to the Directors, who expressed interest and approval of the audit.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
