

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

June 23, 1925.

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. June 23, 1925. The meeting was called to order and presided over by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District. Directors present: Lee; Nuckolls; Breckenridge. Directors absent: none. Nays: none.

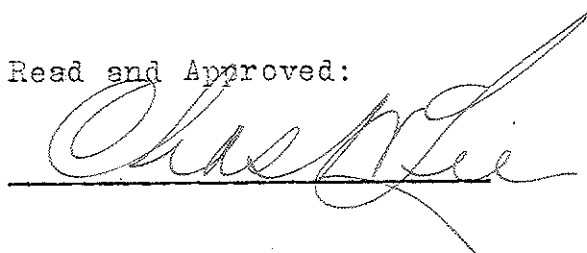
Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.
