

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

June 9, 1925

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. June 9, 1925. The meeting was called to order and presided over by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District. Directors present: Lee; Nuckolls; Breckenridge. Directors absent: none. The minutes of the meetings of June 2 and 3, were read, and upon motion, approved.

Ayes: Breckenridge; Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

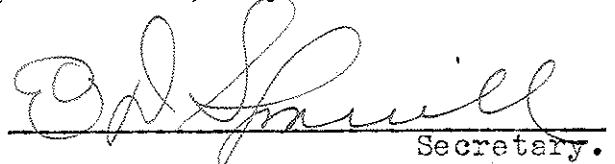
The following work orders were read:

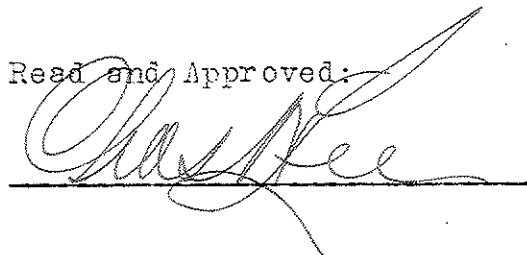
Cole Bros. May 14 Use of dragline in channel
