

A G R E E M E N T.

THIS AGREEMENT made this 31 day of July in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Nine, between Pueblo, a Municipal Corporation, as Party of the First Part, and, The Pueblo Conservancy District, a Political Subdivision, as Party of the Second Part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto that [the South Union Avenue Viaduct, which extends over the "new" river channel and the railroad tracks in front of the Pueblo Union Depot, is now in such a condition at the south end of said viaduct that considerable work and repairs are needed] and, that the southerly bank of the Arkansas River is now in a very unstable condition, and, that both parties hereto are interested and proper parties in taking steps to make the necessary repairs to put the said viaduct in a safe condition.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto that for and in consideration of the party of the first part sponsoring a W. P. A. Project to make said repairs, and, performing all the necessary Engineering Work and Supervision of said repairs and construction in conjunction with repairing the bank at the south end of said viaduct, the party of the Second Part hereby agrees to allow the W. P. A. Project as sponsored by the Party of the First Part to enter into the River Channel to perform the necessary work and make the necessary repairs appertaining thereto.

The Party of the Second Part further agrees to pay the Sponsor's share of the contribution as outlined in the W. P. A. Proposal to be submitted by the Party of the First Part to the W. P. A. in an amount not to exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) in cash.
