MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

Sept. 26, 1925

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. Sept. 26, 1925.

The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee. Directors present: Lee and Nuckolls.

Directors absent: Breckenridge.

Owing to the absence of Mr. Breckenridge, the Secretary, Mr. E. D. Spruill acted as Cheirman of the meeting.

Bids were received and opened for the following contracts: 29a, Fabrication and delivery of steel superstructures for Union Avenue Brudge & Main Street Viaducts; 29b, Removal of steel trusses of Union Avenue Bridge & erection of steel superstructure of Union Avenue Brudge & Main Street Viaduct; 37c, Fabrication and delivery of structural steel for Santa Fe Avenue Subway. Bridge and Main Street Viaduct, in accordance with its proposal; and that the American Bridge Company be awarded Contract No. 37c, fabrication and delivery of structural steel for Santa Fe Avenue Subway, in accordance with its proposal; that all other bids for said contracts be rejected, and the checks accompanying rejected bids be returned; and the officers of the District are hereby authorized and directed to execute contracts accordingly.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, the vote resulting as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.
