CALL FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received by The Pueblo Conservancy District, Pueblo, Colorado, on Tuesday, February 2, 1925, at 10 o'clock A.M., at the office of the Board, 740 First National Bank Bldg., Pueblo, Colorado, for the furnishing of new material required for the West Fourth Street Viaduct, consisting of sidewalk brackets, railing posts, rollers, and miscellaneous shapes and plates as shown and listed on drawings 757, 760 and 924 as prepared by the engineers of the District and estimated at 40,000 pounds; a part of the Official Plan of said District, as set forth more particularly in the maps, plans and specifications prepared by the engineers of The Pueblo Conservancy District and referred to in the bid form.

Proposals must be on the blank forms furnished by the Board, and must be accompanied by a certified check for not less than five per cent (5%) of the aggregate amount of the bid drawn to the order of The Pueblo Conservancy District, as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded a contract, will, within 15 days after the contract is delivered to him for that purpose, execute the same and furnish surety bond satisfactory to the officers of the District for the faithful performance of the contract.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids, and to waive any technical defects, as the interests of the District may require.

Bids should be sealed and marked "Bid on Pueblo Conservancy Contract", and inclosed in an envelope addressed to Chas. W. Lee, Room 740 First National Bank Bldg., Pueblo, Colorado, or presented in person at the time of the letting.
