

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

January 13, 1925

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10:30 A.M. Jan. 13, 1925. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, Chairman of the Board.

Mr. Nuckolls introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the maps, plans and specifications and bid form heretofore prepared by the engineers and officers of the District for the furnishing of new material for the Fourth Street Viaduct, be, and the same are hereby approved, and the Secretary of the District is hereby ordered to advertise by publication for bids for said material and to publish said advertisement in the Pueblo Star Journal and the Pueblo Chieftain, bids to be received February 2, 1925.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, which resulted in the following vote:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none.

Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

Mr. Nuckolls then introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that Contract No. 68 between The Pueblo Conservancy District and W. F. Pigg & Son as the same has been heretofore executed together with the bond securing the performance of said contract, be, and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, which resulted in the following vote:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none.

Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

The following resolution was then presented by Mr. Nuckolls, who moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED that the bid of Blaw-Knox Company of Pittsburgh, be accepted for furnishing material for towers to be supplied to the Southern Colorado Power Company as per letter of Blaw-Knox Company dated January 7, 1925.

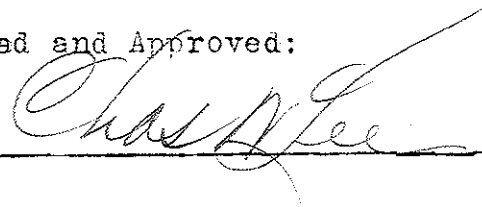
The motion was seconded by Mr. Lee, the vote resulting as follows:
