

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

January 17, 1924.

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Bldg., at 10 o'clock A.M. January 17, 1924. The meeting was presided over by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District. Directors present: Lee, Raber, Wuckolls. Directors absent: none. The minutes of the meetings of January 12, 1924 and January 15, 1924, were both read and upon motion duly approved.

Mr. Raber introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, heretofore, pursuant to public notice and call for bids, proposals in writing have been received by The Pueblo Conservancy District for the doing of certain work and furnishing certain materials, and the said proposals have been examined by the Directors of said District, and they are now fully advised in the premises, NOW, THEREFORE:

Done at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District held in the office of the District the 17th day of January, 1924.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Nuckolls resulting in the following vote:

Ayes: Raber, Nuckolls, Lee, Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion duly passed.

Mr. Nuckolls moved that awards made by the foregoing resolution be announced at 2 P.M. in accordance with previous announcement of the Board of Directors. Mr. Raber seconded the motion and the vote resulted as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls, Raber, Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion duly passed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, at this time, upon motion duly passed, the same was adjourned.
