

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

January 7, 1924.

Pursuant to due call and notice the Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District met at the Council Chamber of the City Hall, Pueblo, Colorado, at 2 o'clock P.M. January 7, 1924.

The meeting was called to order and presided over by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Chas. W. Lee. The minutes were kept by the Secretary, Mr. E. D. Spruill.

Directors present: Lee, Nuckolls, Raber.

Directors absent: none.

There were also present the Treasurer of the District, Mr. Raymond C. Thatcher; Mr. Arthur E. Morgan of the Dayton Morgan Engineering Company, chief engineers of the District; General Counsel Chas. M. Rose, Leo P. Kelly, also Mr. John H. Fry of the firm of Pershing, Nye, Fry & Tallmudge of Denver.

Chairman Lee stated to the meeting that in accordance with duly published notice the Directors had met to open and consider bids for the sale of \$3,600,000. par value of the bonds of the Pueblo Conservancy District and that those present who had not previously handed in their bids could now do so. Thereupon the following resolution was introduced:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT That the bid of The International Trust Company for bonds of the Pueblo Conservancy District be accepted as follows:

- 1. For bonds bearing interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, \$962.788 for each one thousand dollars of said bonds, and in addition thereto accrued interest thereon from the date of their delivery to us,

and in accordance with the terms of said bid, The certified check of the said International Trust Company is hereby ordered retained; all other bids are hereby rejected, and the certified checks accompanying said rejected bids are hereby ordered returned.
