

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

Oct. 13, 1925.

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. Oct. 13, 1925. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District.

Directors present: Lee and Nuckolls.

Mr. Nuckolls introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of

The Pueblo Conservancy District that the Warranty Deed executed the 13th day of October, A.D. 1925, between The Pueblo Conservancy District and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, by Chas. W. Lee, President, on behalf of said District, and attested by the Secretary of said District, and acknowledged on the same day before Lydia E. Keilbach, a Notary Public in and for the County of Pueblo, State of Colorado, conveying certain parcels of land described as Parcel No. 1 and Parcel No. 2, be and the same is hereby confirmed and approved as the deed of The Pueblo Conservancy District, and the officers of said District are hereby instructed to deliver the same to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, grantee therein.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, the vote being as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none.

Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

The following resolution was then introduced by Mr. Nuckolls who moved its adoption:

Keilbach, a Notary Public in and for the County of Pueblo, State of Colorado, conveying certain parcels of land described as Parcel No. 1, Parcel No. 2, Parcel No. 3, Parcel No. 4, Parcel No. 5, Parcel No. 6, Parcel No. 7, Parcel No. 8, Parcel No. 9, and Parcel No. 10, be and the same is hereby confirmed and approved as the deed of The Pueblo Conservancy District, and the officers of said District are hereby instructed to deliver the same to The Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company, grantee therein.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Lee, the vote resulting as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none.

Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

The following work orders were read:

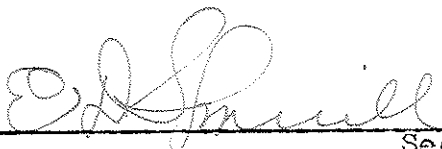
- 185 Oct. 9 Robert W. Hunt Co. Inspection of steel for Union Ave. bridge & Main Street Viaduct.

Mr. Nuckolls made a motion that these orders be approved as read. Motion seconded by Mr. Lee, the vote resulting as follows:

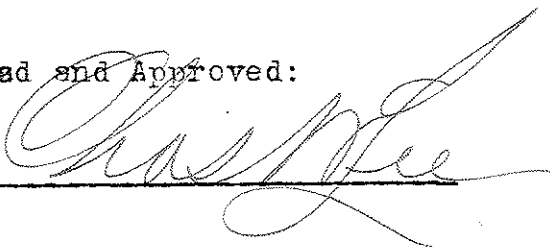
Ayes: Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none.
