

THE MINUTES OF THE FOLLOWING MEETINGS WERE WRITTEN AS NOTES OF CHAS. W. LEE DURING SICKNESS AND ABSENCE OF SECRETARY.

October, 1930.

Had Conservancy meeting with Directors Mathis, Breckenridge and Lee present.

Directors decided they would look with favor on proposed Riverside Drive when the petitioners induced the city or some one else to take charge and construct and maintain the street with the understanding that the District could repossess the land without charge if it was ever needed.

December 4, 1930.

Meeting of Conservancy Board called by Judge John H. Voorhees in his office.

Judge agreed to make bill to be presented to Legislature to have bond on County Treasurer cut to \$100,000.

Agreed District should be inspected each year.

To engage Attorney Rose in endeavor to collect penalties and tax from City.

Judge requested that Secretary have statement in his hands not later than Jan. 10th of each year and that audit be completed not later than Jan. 20th.

January 8, 1931.

Present Breckenridge and Lee.

Discussion of land fronting Entrando St. Was decided by both present that if City Commissioners made application for this land we would give them a grant to use same as long as they used it for a street provided the land was not needed by the Conservancy District. Much discussion has been had on this subject by citizens and were asked by City Attorney what our attitude would be if the city asked for same.
