

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
 PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

November 18, 1927

A meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District at 10:30 A.M. Nov. 18. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee. Directors present: Lee; Breckenridge; Mathis. Directors absent: none. The minutes of the meeting of Oct. 26, 1927 were read, and upon motion, approved.

The following bills were read, and allowed, warrants being ordered drawn on the Treasurer for same:

Mr. Mathis seconded the motion, the vote being as follows:

Thereupon the motion was declared carried.
