

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

November 9, 1928

A meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District at 10:30 A.M. November 9, 1928. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee. Directors present: Lee; Breckenridge; Mathis. Directors absent: none. The minutes of the meeting of July 27, 1928 were read, and upon motion, approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Breckenridge and seconded by Mr. Mathis, the vote being unanimous to sell the steel sheet piling held by the District when chance offered-an inquiry having been received recently.

The old award of \$40.00 as damages to property in the Blocks owned by Mr. Geo. Jackson was again brought up for discussion and it was agreed to offer her attorney \$50.00 as settlement.

It was also moved, seconded and voted to sell the North Side Water Works a piece of land adjacent to their reservoirs, they to draw up all papers and pay cost of surveying in order to get accurate description of same.

After discussion it was agreed to ask Mr. Underwood to meet with the City Commissioners on behalf of the District on the delinquent City tax to the District as shown by Mr. Underwood's recent audit.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion, adjourned.
