

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

February 22, 1926

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 3 P.M. Feb. 22, 1926. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee president of the District.

Directors present: Lee and Breckenridge.

Directors absent: Nuckolls.

The Secretary acted as Chairman of the meeting owing to the absence of Mr. Nuckolls.

The minutes of the meeting of February 17, 1926 were read, and upon motion, approved.

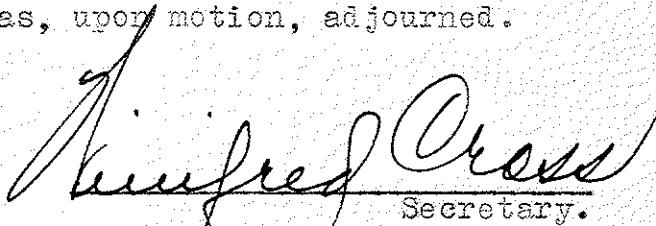
Mr. Breckenridge moved that these orders be

Ayes: Breckenridge; Lee.

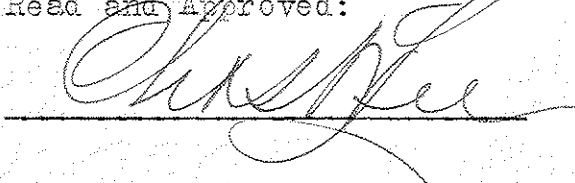
Nays: none.
