

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

April 28, 1925

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. April 28. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, President of the District.

 Union Ave. viaduct.

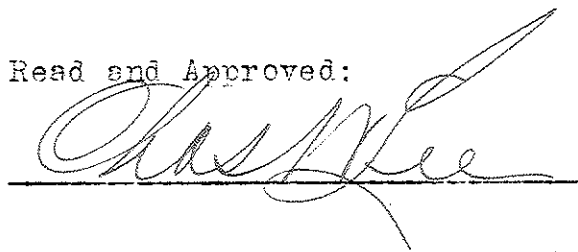
Mr. Nuckolls moved that these orders be approved
