

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

May 9, 1924.

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District at 10 A.M. May 9, 1924.

The bill of Platt Rogers Inc. for meals for surveying parties of the District at the Barrier, was held and discussed, it finally being decided to pay this bill amounting to \$15.20 upon condition that no more such charges be made upon the District.

Mr. Nuckolls introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the Official Plan of the District be amended by setting forth changes in detail as set forth in Supplements C-1, C-2, C-3, C-4, C-5, C-6, C-7 and C-8 hereto attached; that said Supplements be and the same are hereby approved and confirmed as part of the Official Plan of The Pueblo Conservancy District.

That the officers of the District be hereby authorized to take the necessary measures to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Raber, resulting in the following vote:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Raber; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion duly passed.

The following resolution was introduced by Mr. Reber, who moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED; In instances where the Construction Fund Assessment Record shows a total assessment of \$10 or less against any property, that the extension be made as a total sum due in the last year of installment series; the total of the interest so included shall not exceed the amount of interest if extended for each year; and further, that said Assessment Record be marked, in such instances only, as follows: "Payable in whole or in part at any time."

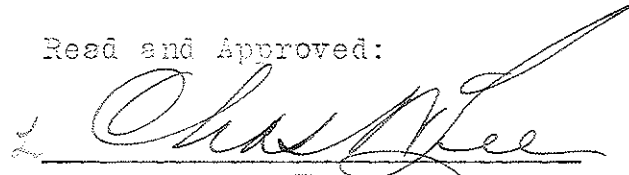

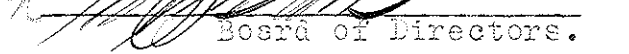
The motion was seconded by Mr. Nuckolls and when put to the vote, resulted as follows:
