June 24, 1924.

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. June 24, 1924. BE IT RESOLVED By The Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the installments of interest maturing July 1, 1924 on outstanding bonds of The Pueblo Con-

servency District shall be paid out of the Construction Fund, and said Fund shall be reimbursed as the interest is collected upon assessments; and the Treasurer of the District is hereby authorized to deposit funds for the amount of said interest according to the tenor and effect of the Conservancy District bonds outstanding.


Mr. Raber seconded the motion, the vote resulting as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Raber; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.




Accordingly warrants were ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the interest on registered and unregistered bonds as follows:
