MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

July 10, 1958

A Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pueblo Conservancy District was called on the above date at the office of President Holmes, 322 West Pitkin Avenue, Pueblo, Colorado.

Those Present: John M. Holmes, W. T. Mathis and L. M. Rhoades.

It was explained by Holmes that since the Blackburn Engineering Company had dissolved and ceased operations that the District was without anyone to take care of the force account of the District.

The City of Pueblo had advised the District that certain weeds upon its property must immediately be cut. It was moved by Holmes and seconded by Mathis, that Holmes should make connection with a reliable concern to take care of the force account of the District in the future. Motion was carried.

Holmes then explained ~~that~~ the operations of the District's office. It was moved by Rhoades and seconded by Mathis that Mrs. B. F. Greene be employed by the District as bookkeeper and stenographer effective July 15, 1958, at a salary of \$50.00 per month.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
