

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

July 22, 1924

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10:30 A.M. July 22. BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the plans and specifications heretofore prepared by the Morgan Engineering Company for Contract No. 49 (Local Freight House and Transfer Platforms) be and the same are hereby approved and made a part of the Official Plan of The Pueblo Conservancy District, as

well as the bid forms and the form of advertisement with reference to said Contract, and said advertisement is hereby ordered published on July 23, 1924, July 30, 1924 and August 6, 1924 in the Pueblo Star Journal and the Pueblo Chieftain.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Nuckolls and when put to the vote, resulted as follows:

Ayes: Raber; Nuckolls; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the resolution duly passed.

Mr. Nuckolls introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District: That the Treasurer of The Pueblo Conservancy District is hereby authorized to sell at market price U. S. securities in amount of \$100,000 per value, now held by said officer as part of proceeds of bonds of said District.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Raber and when put to the vote, resulted as follows:

Ayes: Nuckolls; Raber; Lee. Nays: none. Thereupon the Chairman declared the resolution duly passed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion, adjourned.
