With reference to funds of the District deposited in the Arkansas Valley Bank, Greene reported that on September 16, 1953, a six months time deposit certificate for \$25,000 matured. He stated that following instructions from Mr. Holmes, this \$25,000 was deposited in the checking account of the District, which added to \$25,000 previously deposited in this account made the total of \$50,000. In compliance with Greene's request for approval of the Board, Mr. Pryor moved that the increasing of the amount in the checking account at the Arkansas Valley Bank to \$50,000 be ratified and approved. Mr. Mathis seconded the motion which was unanimously carried.
