MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

September 9, 1924.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that Contract No. 48 between The Pueblo Conservancy District and A. F. Cherry as the same has heretofore been executed together with the bond securing the performance of said contract, be and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Lee, the vote resulting as follows:

Thereupon the Chairman declared the resolution adopted.

Mr. Lee then introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that Contract No. 26e between The Pueblo Conservancy District and the Minneapolis Steel and Machinery Company as the same has been heretofore executed together with the bond securing the performance of said contract, be and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Nuckolls, the vote being as follows:

Ayes: Lee; Nuckolls. Nays: None.

Thereupon the Chairman declared the motion passed.

There being no further business to come before the meeting it was, upon motion, adjourned.
