

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE PUEBLO CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

Oct. 28, 1925.

The regular weekly meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. Oct. 28, 1925. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District.

Mr. Breckenridge then introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District that the officers of the District are hereby authorized to convey Lot Two (2), Reiley's Subdivision of Block "I" to Nellie Cureton in consideration of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars.

Mr. Lee seconded the motion, the vote being as follows:
