June 3, 1925


A special meeting of the Board of Directors of The Pueblo Conservancy District was held in the office of the District, Room 740 Thatcher Building at 10 A.M. June 3, 1925. The meeting was called to order by Chas. W. Lee, president of the District.
Directors present: Lee and Nuckolls.
Directors absent: Breckenridge.
Mr. Spruill, Secretary of the District presided as Chairman of the meeting.


According to advertisement, bids for construction of the south abutment of Main Street Viaduct and for the construction of the Santa Fe Avenue Subway, were received, opened, read and tabulated by Mr. Lee, as follows:
